Day 01 Arrive Kochi

On arrival at Kochi Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure.

Kochi, or more familiarly, Cochin is a city of many parts. Around for a long, long time, Kochi played a pivotal role in the development of shipping and trade in the region. Kochi's prime location on the west coast, its fine bay and protected harbour made it popular with seafarers and merchant ships who made frequent stops to stock up on spices, coffee and wood en-route to the rich markets of Europe and West Asia. And so down the ages, Kochi prospered as a busy port city and commercial centre. Its seafront is still extremely relevant to Cochin and to India: In the evening, you will be taken to a Kathakali dance centre where you will witness the most elaborate of the dance forms in southern India

Chinese Fishing Nets, Dutch Palace (Closed On Fridays) And Jews Synagogue (closed on Fridays, Saturdays & Jew Festival days)

The Paradesi Synagogue is the oldest active synagogue located in Kochi Constructed in 1568, It is one of seven synagogues of the Malabar Yehudan people or Cochin Jewish community in the Kingdom of Cochin. Paradesi is a word used in several Indian languages, and the literal meaning of the term is "foreigners", applied to the synagogue because it was historically used by the typical Jews, Chinese fishing nets (Cheena vala) are that are fixed land installations for fishing. While commonly known as "Chinese fishing nets.

Day 03 Munnar Breakfast

Today morning after breakfast proceed for a sightseeing tour of **Munnar**.

Munnar is a town in the southwestern state of Kerala and is situated around 1600 m above sea level, in the Western Ghats range of mountains The name Munnar is believed to mean "three rivers referring to the location at the confluence of the Madhurapuzha, Nallathanni and Kundaly rivers Munnar town is situated on the Kannan Devan Hills village in Devikulam taluk and is the largest panchayat in the Idukki district in Kerala.

Tea Museum

Munnar has a legacy of its own when it comes to the origins and evolution of tea plantations. Taking account of this legacy and to preserve and showcase some of the exquisite and interesting aspects of the genesis and growth of tea plantations in Kerala's high ranges, a museum exclusively for tea was opened some years ago by Tata Tea in Munnar. This Tea Museum houses artifacts, photographs and machineries; all of which have a story to tell about the origins and growth of tea plantations in Munnar. The museum is located at the Nallathanni Estate of Tata Tea in Munnar and is worth a visit

Day 04 Munnar - Periyar (110 kms, 03-04 hrs drive) Breakfast

After breakfast we drive from Munnar to Periyar through the scenic roads. On arrival check in hotel

Periyar Tiger Reserve, Thekkady, is an example of nature's bounty, with great scenic charm, rich biodiversity and providing veritable visitor satisfaction. Sprawled over an area of 925 Sq.km., Periyar is one of the 27 tiger reserves in India, South India's most popular wildlife sanctuary, Periyar encompasses 777 sq km and a 26-sq-km artificial lake created by the British in 1895. The vast region is home to bison, sambar, wild boar, langur, 900 to 1000 elephants and 35 to 40 hard-to-spot tigers. Firmly established on both the Indian and foreigner tourist trails, the place can sometimes feel a bit like Disneyland-in-the-Ghats, but its mountain scenery and jungle walks make for an enjoyable visit. Bring warm and waterproof clothing

Afternoon enjoy boat ride sharing on Lake Periyar to view the wildlife.

You have some options for the trekking etc *on direct payment basis* if time permits on the next day also visit the local spice plantations and spice market. Return to Hotel for overnight stay.







Day 05 Periyar - Kumarakom (185 kms, 05 hrs drive approx.) Breakfast

After breakfast drive from Periyar to Kumarakom, on arrival check in at your hotel in Kumarakom


Day 07 Kumarakom - Alleppey (45 Kms, 01 hr drive approx.) Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast leave Kumarakom leisurely around 10 30 hrs and drive to **Alleppey jetty** point to board your **Houseboat for a** cruising on serene backwaters. The Kerala backwaters are a network of brackish lagoons and canals lying parallel to the Arabian Sea of the Malabar coast of Kerala state in south-western India.

One night cruise on the backwaters of the Alappuzha is one of the most popular cruises offered. A round trip, in which you board the boat at Alappuzha and disembark at Alappuzha after having spent the night in the tranquillity of the Backwaters. The cruise takes you through the clear waters of the prominent Punnamada Lake — the venue of the legendary Nehru Trophy Snake Boat Race. You can visit the 400-year-old Champakkulam church, one of the 7 churches established by St. Thomas. The Chavara Bhavan, located 6 km from Alleppey, is another interesting place that one can't afford to miss. The ancestral home of the Blessed Kuriakose Elias Chavara, the Chavara Bhavan houses the legendary 250-year-old beacon of light — preserved intact in its original and primitive form.

Day 08 Alleppey - Marari (15 Kms, 30 minutes drive approx.) Breakfast

Checkout after breakfast from your houseboat and check in to your hotel in Marari. Day at leisure
