

## Horse Safari in Rajasthan – *The Royal Experience*



**08 Days / 07 Nights**

**Udaipur 01 Night – Kumbhalgarh 01 Night – Camp around Muthana Lake 01 Night – Camp around Dantiwara Lake 01 Night – Camp around Bali Forest 01 Night– Camp around Jawai Bandh 02 Nights**

*Ride the unique Marwari horse breed over the open landscape of the Thar desert for adventure of lifetime ...*

*Marwari horses are unique to India and have curly lyre shaped ears that touch at the tip. A desert breed, they are the war horse of choice for Rajput warriors in ancient times - you cannot ride this breed outside India!*





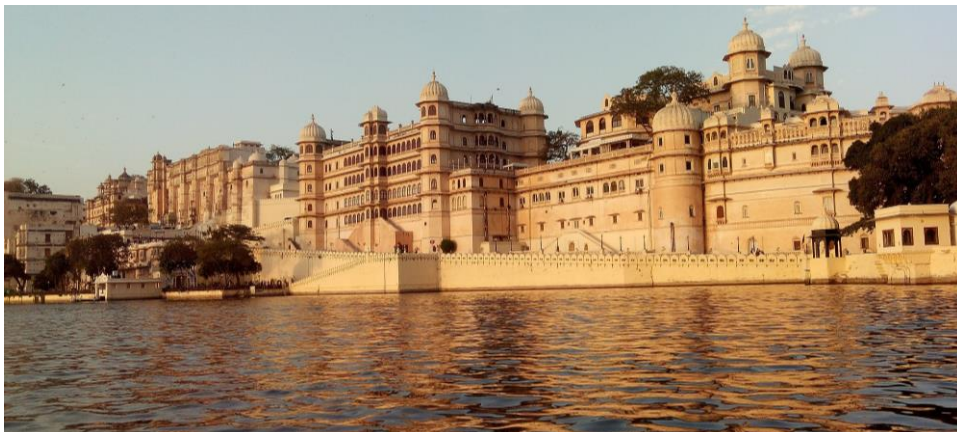
### **Day 01 :: Arrive Udaipur / Lunch, Dinner**

Upon arrival at Udaipur, you will be met & transferred to your hotel.

Late afternoon boat ride around Lake Pichola (*sharing*), beside Lake Pichola, with the ochre and purple ridges of the wooded Aravalli Hills stretching away in every direction, Udaipur has a romance of setting unmatched in Rajasthan and arguably in all India. Fantastical palaces, temples, havelis and countless narrow, crooked, colourful streets add the human counterpoint to the city's natural charms.

## Day 02 :: Udaipur – Kumbhalgarh / Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Morning enjoy sightseeing of Udaipur including famous attractions of city.

Udaipur is the city of cream, rose and honeysuckle hues. The huge, cupola-crowned City Palace lines the eastern shore of Lake Pichola, with its balconies gazing out at Udaipur's other famous landmark, the Lake Palace – a fairy-tale confection that seems to float on the lake's waters, gleaming by day and spotlit by night. Eastward, away from the lake shore, extends a tangled inner city of lanes lined with homes, temples, shops and businesses that is fascinating to explore.

In the Afternoon: Transfer by road North to Kumbhalgarh 2 hours drive approx.

On arrival checkin at your hotel.

### Day 03 :: Kumbhalgarh – Muthana Lake / Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Morning we visit the magnificent **Kumbhalgarh Fort**.

Kumbhalgarh Fort is the second most important fort of Rajasthan after Chittorgarh. This unconquerable fortress is secured under the kind protection of the Aravali ranges. Kumbhalgarh Fort was built by Maharana Rana Kumbha in the 15th century. Encircled by thirteen elevated mountain peaks, the fort is constructed on the top most ridges around 1,914 meters above sea level. The fortifications of the fort extend to the length of 36 kilometers and this fact has made this fort to be in the international records. It is stated to be the second longest wall in the world, the first being "The Great Wall of China". The huge complex of the Fort has numerous palaces, temples and gardens making it more magnificent

Later in the Morning: **Start Horse Safari tour** of Rajasthan.

Ride down through the **Khumbalgarh Sanctuary** and **Ghanerao forest**.

We enter the sanctuary near Kumbhalgarh Fort and pick our way through the wooded sanctuary using old paths, crossing small rivers to the edge of the Ghanerao forest. The route is shaded and quiet, although harbours much wildlife – keep your eyes open, you never know which animals are watching you through the trees. Late picnic lunch en route, arriving at Muthana Lake at dusk

**Day 04 :: Muthana Lake - Dantiwara Lake/ Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

Full day ride to **Dantiwara Lake**. Passing through villages and riding in the plains of the Aravalli hills, stopping for a picnic lunch, we reach our camp situated in front of the lake.

**Overnight : at Camp around Dantiwara Lake**

**Day 05 :: Dantiwara Lake - Bali Forest / Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

Full day ride to Bali Forest.

We make our way along the bottom of the Aravalli hills South West to Perwa. We pass villages and rural farmsteads, making our way through the volcanic smooth rock formations, stopping in the shade for a long picnic lunch.

### Day 06 :: Bali Forest – Jawai Bandh / Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

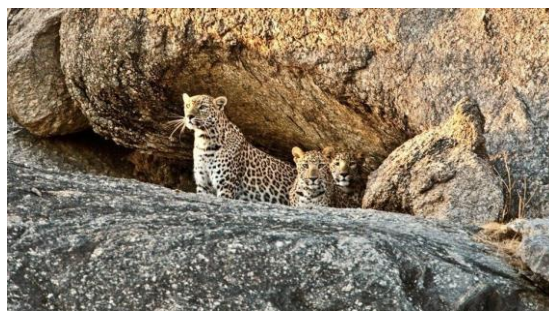
Full day ride to Jawai Bandh. Today we continue onwards to reach **Jawai Bandh** – Lying at the heart of an untrammled wilderness, where leopards roam wild and free encapsulated in a landscape surrounded by craggy granite formations of caves, kopjes, *Anogeissus* scrub and winding sand river-beds.

Jawai Bandh (Dam) is situated near Sumerpur town in Pali District of Rajasthan & was built by Maharaja Umaid Singh of Jodhpur. Jawai Bandh Conservation Reserve is famous for Leopards. The Jawai leopards reside in a stunning landscape surrounded by granite rocks and the Jawai dam.

### Day 07 :: In & Around Jawai Bandh / Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Morning ride to search for **Leopard** sighting in the area.

This area is where “the hills throw the moon out and just as soon absorb its glow into their gorges. Where nomadic Rabari herdsmen are as much a part of the earth's tales as the mysterious felines that grace these hills and vanish at will into their folds. Where pastoral fields meet and merge with wild grasslands and the swells of the JAWAI Bandh's waters lap at the toes of mighty granite forms. Where flamingos flock and cranes in their hundreds dance to springtime. This special location, the unique flavor of this land and its offerings, provide for an entirely different experience from the rest of Rajasthan”.

Evening enjoy a **Jeep safari** (*sharing*) to search for Leopard sighting in the Area .

**Day 08 :: Jawai Bandh – Udaipur / Breakfast**

After breakfast, departure transfer from **Jawai Bandh** to **Udaipur Airport** / place to be **advised in Udaipur** for further arrangements.

## Leopard Trail



*The Leopard trail is a wonderful mix of terrain and history ~ starting in Udaipur we then transfer to meet your horses high in the Aravelli hills 1100 meters up at Kumbhalgarh Fort. We ride down through the wooded forest, passing cool streams to arrive on the hot plains, camping by farms and lakes. We make our way between the smooth rocks and hills to the scrub forest at Bali, and then set camp for two nights at Jawai Bandh, transferring to jeeps for morning and evening excursions into the park for Leopard safari, finally we transfer to Jodhpur to experience the imposing Mehrangarh Fort.*

### Synopsis of Leopard Trail

\* Anytime of year (except monsoon in July / August) \*

Book your own private Leopard Trail ride (minimum 2 people)  
7 night itinerary consisting of 2 nights in hotels, 5 nights camping  
Average riding distance 25km - 30km per day / 4 - 6 hours in the saddle per day with a break for picnic lunch.

Sightseeing at Udaipur (City Palace), Kumbhalgarh (Fort) included. **Meals on Full Board basis.**
