Day 01 Arrive Delhi

Upon your arrival at Delhi Airport, our team will be holding your name signage by "Adventure World" in the arrival hall.

You will be met and transferred to your Hotel for Check-in with welcome briefing

Our travel manager will then outline your wonderful itinerary ahead.

Enjoy rest day at leisure (perhaps by the poolside or hotel spa treatments on your own).

In 1911 the British Imperial Government moved capital of British India from Calcutta to Delhi. And accordingly construction in that year began. There are at least eight historical Delhi's, each constructed on, or near, the ruins of its predecessor, leaving a modern-day citadel that's dotted with ancient monuments. It offers a glimpse of both ancient and modern day India. The city of Delhi is a blend of two different yet perfectly balanced parts, the Old and the New Delhi. Old Delhi, founded as Shahjahanabad in 1639 as the capital of the great Mughal Empire, and New Delhi, designed by british architect Sir Edwin Lutyens and set-up in 1931 by viceroy of india Lord Irwin.

Day 02 Delhi Old & New Delhi city tour / Breakfast, Lunch

Step-back in time and discover the glory of the great Mughal empire and British raj of India. After Breakfast you will be met by our expert Delhi Guide and our company Chauffeur, who will take you on a journey thru **Old Delhi**, founded as Shahjahanabad in 1639 as the capital of the great Mughal Empire, and Lutyens City - **New Delhi**, designed by British architect Sir Edwin Lutyens and set-up in 1931 by viceroy of India Lord Irwin.

Our first stop will be old walled-city of Delhi. We will visit the marvellous red-sandstoned Jama Masjid Mosque built by Mughal emperor and maker of taj mahal – Shah Jahan in 1644 AD showcasing finest indo-islamic architectures. Afterwards, we hop-on a traditional Rickshaw Ride tour exploring real life, tangy flavours and buzz of old city thru maze-like streets of the iconic wholesale bazaar Chandni Chowk and asia's largest spice trading markets Khari Baoli along with tasting the delicacies of Delhi through the Paranthe Wali Gali – Gali Paranthe Wali is a small street in the jam packed Chadni Chowk district. The street is famous for the number of restaurants specialising in Parathas, hence the name (Indian version of stuffed bread fried in Oil Pan & served with different chutneys & curries next we take you to enjoy the Kulhad Lassi – prepared by blending yogurt, water & Sugar with aromas of Kevra.


Our ride ends with a photo-stop outside the imperial residence of Mughal empire and unesco heritage site **The Red Fort**, built in 1638 and rumoured to have the decapitated bodies of prisoners built into its foundations for luck.











Afterwards we will arrive at the infamous **Lutyens Delhi** aka the New Delhi City, known for its innovative architecture from the 1930's British raj, and now the political heart of independent India. This colonial city with its European influences was a power symbol of the British Empire. We will explore fine works of Sir Edwin Lutyen, that later became the fabric and features of modern India. We cover New Delhi's most imposing sites such as Gandhi Smriti, the remembrance home - museum of Mahatma Gandhi; here on 30th Jan 1948 the father of India was assassinated. Ceremonial boulevard Raj Path designed by Lutyens in 1921 taking similarities from the "Champs Elysee of France". Here we explore princely State Houses and architectures of North - South Block incl India Gate, a 42m-high stone memorial arch pays tribute to 70,000 soldiers of British Indian Army who died in the first world war. Presidents estate Rashtrapati Bhawan, former home to the British viceroy and today the largest residence of any head of state in the world. The House of Parliament, designed by Sir Herbert Baker in 1912 to construct a new administrative capital of British India. Afterwards, we journey to central parks of Delhi surrounded with downtown markets Connaught Place named after the duke of Connaught. This horse-shoe shaped market was built in the spirit of British colonial rule, as a grand shopping place where the new imperial city and the older native settlement would participate in trading. Later in evening you will drop back at your hotel. Inbetween the tour we take you to the famous Gulati Restaurant at Pandara Road for your buffet Lunch. Later return to your Hotel for relax & overnight stay.









Day 03 Delhi – Jaipur / Breakfast, Dinner

Today morning after breakfast / check out you will be picked up from your hotel and driven to **Jaipur** (260 kms), a historic pink washed city and gateway to India's most flamboyant state - Rajasthan. (drive includes enroute stop for clean restrooms).

Upon arrival, you will be check in at your hotels. Enjoy rest day at leisure.

In the evening, we take you to enjoy Dinner at **Chokhi Dhani, Jaipur** to experience the Authentic Rajasthani food with Heritage village experience.

the picturesque capital of Rajasthan, Jaipur is awash in pink - the colour associated with hospitality in Rajput culture. Built in 1727 A.D. by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh JI, Jaipur displays a remarkable harmony and architectural splendour, most notably the renowned Palace of the Winds. The ancient heart of the Pink City still beats in its fairytale palaces, rugged fortresses perched on barren hills and broad avenues that dot the entire city.

Day 04 Jaipur jeep safari, tuk-tuk ride, and sightseeing / Breakfast, Lunch

After <u>Breakfast</u> our expert Jaipur guide will meet you for briefing on your heritage program for the day. We will proceed towards the city outskirts (10 Km drive) and enter the ancient town of **Amer** that offers remarkable Rajput-Mughal architectures. The picturesque situation of Amer at the mouth of a rocky mountain, in which nestles a lake, has attracted travellers including renowned French botanist Victor Jacque Mont. We will explore UNESCO world heritage site and a must see of Jaipur! **The Amber Fortress**. Our **Jeep Safari** begins to climb the uphill located fort passing thru the vibrant local life residing inside the fort walls. <u>Following ethical tourism we discourage elephant rides</u>. Built in 16th century by Rajput commander Raja Man Singh I, the fortress offers magnificent hilltop views with an intricate mirror palace and fine blends of Hindu-Rajasthani architecture.

Inbetween the tour we take you to the famous Restaurant Niro's to enjoy Lunch.

Afterwards we will drive you to the heart of Jaipur's city-centre. Enroute we will take a photo-stop outside Water Palace - **Jal Mahal** located in the centre of Man Sagar Lake housing various migratory birds and surrounded by Aravalli Ranges. We will arrive at the **Patrika Gates**, which are hand-painted in a traditional style showcasing vibrant characteristics of Rajasthan. Each pillar has intricate details and uses a variety of colours which makes it seem like a rainbow walkway. The gate is the entrance to Jawahar Circle Garden and it's perfect symmetry makes for a beautiful photograph. Our tour continues as we will arrive at Astronomical Observatory - **Jantar Mantar**, begun by Jai Singh II in 1728 that is a collection of bizarre giant architectural astronomical instruments built for measuring the heavens and features the world's largest stone sundial. The name is derived from the Sanskrit *yanta mantr*, meaning 'instrument of calculation'. Here our expert Guide will teach you how these bizarre instruments work to me asure celestial objects.

Next we will reach at the iconic **City Palace & Museum of Jaipur**. A complex of courtyards, gardens and buildings, the impressive City Palace is right in the centre of the Old City. This Palace is a paradise of royal heritage history housing rare galleries from British Raj to the Rajput Era. Inside the complex we will explore the Pitam Niwas Chowk, where four glorious gates represent the seasons, from Peacock Gate of autumn, to Lotus Gate of summer. Beyond this *chowk* (square) is a private palace, the Chandra Mahal, which is still the residence of descendants of the royal family. The Mubarak Mahal, built as a reception centre for visiting dignitaries showcases multi-arched and colonnaded construction by renowned architect Sir Swinton Jacob. Finally The Armoury Room, housing the country's best collection of weapons and ceremonial items elegantly engraved.

Our heritage tour concludes with a **Bazaar Walk** and **Tuk-Tuk Tour** thru the ancient street markets of downtown Jaipur Bazaar. Chaos and amusement goes hand-in-hand in these maze-like streets, so feel free to take a photo-stop anywhere or if you fancy shopping for local arts & crafts. These bazaars are known for bangle street - Maniharon ka Rasta, to the 'Chandpol Bazaar' and 'Khazanewalon Ka Rasta' meaning a treasure trove, offering antiques and intricately carved handicrafts out of marble, stone, wood, and other handlooms. Inside bazaar we will arrive at Jaipur's most distinctive landmark, **The Palace of Winds - Hawa Mahal.** Built in a unique pink-coloured beehive design that is certainly hard to miss.

Enjoy **Tea & Evening Snacks** on streets of Pink City.

Before sunset we will return back to Hotel enroute taking a photostop outside the **Albert Hall Museum**, full of artwork and curios unique to this region. Centrally located in the midst of lush Ram Niwas Gardens of Jaipur, Albert Hall Museum with its intricate interiors is a treat to eyes especially when lit up during the evening with its exterior, passages and corridors illuminated with glorious colourful lighting.

Day 05 Jaipur - Agra / Breakfast, Dinner

Today morning after breakfast / check out you will be picked up at 0830 hrs from your hotel and driven to the legacy city of Mughal-Empire - **Agra** (250 Kms), home of Taj Mahal. Drive will include enroute stop for clean restrooms.

Upon arrival in Agra our representative will meet you for Check-In at Hotel.

Enjoy rest day at leisure (perhaps by the poolside or hotel spa treatments on your own).

Later, at the break of dusk special arrangements will be made for to visit the sacred Yamuna riverside – **Mehtab Bagh Gardens** for a picturesque **Sunset Viewing** of the **Taj Mahal**. Emperor Babur originally built it as the last in a series of 11 parks designed to protect the Taj from the erosive effects of the sand blown across the river and offers majestic sunset views of the great mausoleum as the gardens surrounding the Taj are perfectly aligned with the ones here.

After the tour we take you to dine at the famous rooftop restaurant of Clarks Shiraz Hotel – **The Mughal Room.** After the dinner Return to your Hotel & stay overnight.

Day 06 Agra Taj Mahal at sunrise and sightseeing / Breakfast, Lunch

Today early morning we take you to sunrise grand tour of **The Taj Mahal**. Spanning an area of about 1,000 acres (400 hectares), this majestic architectural wonder offers incredible sights. Built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved third wife, Mumtaz Mahal, and combines Persian, Turkish and Indian architectural styles. On your guided tour, admire the structure's magnificent construction, the intricate exterior and interior decor, the beautiful garden and the outlying red-sandstone buildings. Capture the changing faces of the Taj in different light conditions. Our expert guides will also help you find special vantage points for perfect photography moments of Taj. Afterward Taj tour we return back to hotel for Breakfast.

Agra is famous as being home to one of the Seven Wonders of the world - the Taj Mahal. The architectural splendour of the mausoleums, the fort and the palaces is vivid reminder of the opulence of the legendary Mughal empire, of which Agra was the capital in the 16th century.

Later in the morning, we will journey through the old-cities traditional houses, British raj colonies and Mughal architectures to arrive at India's finest Mughal fortress - **The Red Fort of Agra.** A UNESCO world heritage site and the imperial residence of 16th century rulers of 'Mughal Dynasty'. After tour return to hotel to relax

In the afternoon we take you to the famous restaurant **Peshawri** at ITC Mughal Hotel in Agra to enjoy **Lunch**.

After the Lunch make a visit to Marble factory at **Kalakriti Emporium** to view how the intricate carvings on marble structures are done. Next enjoy Live Music and dance performance at **Mohabbat the Taj Show** (optional activity on direct payment).

Today early morning, we transfer you to Tundla Train Station (outskirts of Agra, 25 Kms away) to connect Train to **Lucknow**.

In the afternoon, we take you to the tour of Lucknow visiting **Bada Imambara** as well as **Chota Imambara**, later we take you to the famous **Rumi Darwaza** & **Husainabad Clock Tower**.

Evening we take you to stroll around **Aminabad Market** - stands as one of Lucknow's oldest and most bustling shopping destinations. This vibrant market is a treasure trove of affordable and cheap clothing, footwear, accessories, and household items.

Later enjoy **Dinner** at your hotel in Lucknow.

- Tunday Kababi: Famous for its Galouti Kebabs (These melt-in-your-mouth kebabs were originally created for an aging Nawab who had lost his teeth but not his appetite for rich flavors. Made with finely minced meat and a blend of over 150 spices), Tunday Kababi is a must-visit for anyone exploring Lucknow's food scene.
- Dastarkhwan: Known for its Nihari and Kulcha (Nihari, a slow-cooked meat stew, is traditionally eaten as a breakfast dish in Lucknow. It is rich, flavorful, and best enjoyed with Kulcha, a soft, leavened bread that soaks up the delicious gravy. This combination is a must-try for those looking to experience the hearty flavors of Lucknow's cuisine), Dastarkhwan offers a taste of traditional Lucknawi cuisine in a relaxed setting.
- Idris Biryani: For an authentic Biryani experience (Lucknawi Biryani is a dish that reflects the city's rich culinary heritage. Unlike other regional variations, Lucknawi Biryani is known for its subtle flavors and use of aromatic spices. The rice is cooked to perfection, layered with tender meat, and served with a side of raita, making it a complete meal in itself), Idris Biryani in the bustling streets of Chowk is the place to go.
- Ram Asrey: A legendary sweet shop where you can enjoy Makhan Malai (For those with a sweet tooth, Makhan Malai is a dessert not to be missed. This creamy, frothy delicacy is made by churning milk and cream until it reaches a light, airy consistency, and is then flavored with saffron, cardamom, and nuts). and other traditional desserts.

Later return to your hotel & relax.

Varanasi is a city in the northern Indian state of Uttar Pradesh dating to the 11th century B.C. Regarded as the spiritual capital of India, the city draws Hindu pilgrims who bathe in the Ganges River's sacred waters and perform funeral rites. Along the city's winding streets are some 2,000 temples, including Kashi Vishwanath, the "Golden Temple," dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. Magical auspicious city of Varanasi, best described as the India of your imagination! This is India's most holy city and has a spiritual legacy stretching across 3,000 years.

Day 10 Varanasi Tour - Sunrise Boat Cruise - Sunset Aarti Ceremony Breakfast, Dinner

Varanasi is believed to offer its visitors 'Moksha', liberation from cycle of rebirth. Our sacred journey in this holy city begins with **Sunrise Boat Cruise** on **'The Ganges River'**. Capture picturesque views riverfront steps 'Ghats' filled with ancient temples, classic houses and hundreds of pilgrims who come to wash-away their sins in this sacred river. Witness crematory rituals at **Burning Ghats** of 'Manikarnika' and understand the meaning of Karma, Salvation and Afterlife. Return to Hotel for breakfast and rest.

After breakfast, we begin a **Heritage Walk Tour** through maze-like streets of Varanasi. First stop, we visit a traditional **Indian Wrestling Joint 'Akhada'** and watch wrestlers perform using traditional exercise tools or doing 'Kushti' – an Indian wrestling on fresh mud pits. Pure Varanasi Silk is world-renowned, and next we visit a **Traditional Silk Weaving Unit** to experience this rare art. Explore 1776 built **Vishwananth Gold Temple** covered in 800 Kg of Gold dedicated to 'Lord Shiva', the principle deity of Hinduism. Outside temple enjoy a session of **Indian Palm Reading** by Hindu Astrologers locally called 'Jyotish'.

Inbetween we take you to explore the local bazaar and experience the famous delicacies of Varanasi.

In the evening we take you to riverfront of The Ganges to participate with the locals in a **Sunset Ceremony Aarti**, a Sanskrit prayer performed to worship The Ganges River by several priests, accompanied by bells, drums, cymbals and flower petals.

Later after the aarti ceremony, we take you to the famous **Shree Shivay Thali Dining** to enjoy the **Thali dinner**. After the dinner you will be drop back to your hotel for overnight stay.

We also visit Mani Bhawan and Hanging Gardens. Our tour ends at the famed bazaar of British Bombay called Crawford Market operating since 1869 as the oldest flea market in the world. Evening return back to your hotel.
